The second cohort launched on May 18, 2022.

The award recognizes organizations that have "benefited kids and education, people under-represented in tech, the environment, healthcare, and other worthy missions." The Black Boardroom Initiative was recognized for its efforts to increase the diversity of S&P 500 corporate boards by training cohorts of diverse executives. The Geeks Give Back honorees were selected based on community nominations, along with input from GeekWire Awards judges.
