

Markus Funk Quoted in Multiple Publications Regarding a Texas Intruder Shooting Case

Partner T. Markus Funk was quoted in multiple publications regarding a contentious self-defense case.

In this case, the armed customer was sitting in a booth in the same room as someone he thought was pointing a firearm at patrons—creating a reasonable belief that force was necessary and making the issue of retreating void, said Markus, a lawyer and author of "Rethinking Self-Defence: The 'Ancient Right's' Rationale Disentangled."
