

A Standard Document creating a revocable transfer on death deed (TOD deed or TODD) under Washington law. It allows a real property owner (also called a grantor or transferor) to designate a beneficiary to receive title to real property on the owner's death without a probate proceeding or trust administration. This Standard Document has integrated notes with explanations and drafting tips.
