# **California's Prop 22 Passage Allows Tech-Based Companies to Classify Drivers as Contractors**

On Election Day 2020, California voters approved Proposition 22 which allows some gig economy companies to continue to classify drivers as independent contractors. These app-based drivers also will be guaranteed minimum earnings, healthcare subsidies, and vehicle insurance, and entitled to anti-discrimination and sexual harassment protections.
