Wetlands Jurisdictional Determinations are Final Agency Actions Subject to Immediate Judicial Review

The U.S. Supreme Court ruled yesterday that a wetlands jurisdictional determination by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers under the Clean Water Act is a final agency action subject to judicial review. <u>Hawkes Co., Inc. v. U.S. Army Corps of Engineers</u>, <u>578 U.S.</u> (2016).
