## **Additional Paid Leave for COVID-19 Vaccinations**

On May 18, 2021, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors passed an urgency <u>ordinance</u> related to paid leave for COVID-19 vaccinations. The law only applies to employers in the <u>unincorporated</u> areas of Los Angeles County. It provides additional time off for full- and part-time employees who have exhausted time off under California's 2021 COVID-19 Supplemental Paid Sick Leave and who perform any work in the unincorporated areas of the County. Full-time employees who meet certain conditions are entitled to use up to 4 hours of additional paid time off per vaccination injection. Part-time employees are entitled to a prorated portion of additional paid time off. Employers must post written notice of the law in a conspicuous place once it becomes available on the <u>Los Angeles County Department of Consumer and Business Affairs website</u>. The ordinance will sunset on August 31, 2021.
