Richards v. Safeway, No. 13cv4317 (N.D. Cal.): Plaintiffs allege that frozen waffles labeled "100% Natural" contain an allegedly "synthetic" ingredient, sodium acid pyrophosphate. [Complaint](#). *Swearingen v. Attune Foods*, No. 13cv4541 (N.D. Cal.): Plaintiffs allege that Attune's chocolate bars, Erewhon crackers and cereals, and Uncle Sam's cereals are "misbranded" because the labels list ECJ as an ingredient rather than sugar. [Complaint](#). *Marty v. Anheuser-Busch Cos.*, No. 13cv23656 (S.D. Fla.): Plaintiff alleges that Anheuser-Busch has misled consumers and charged a premium price for Beck's beer, which the complaint alleges is marketed as a high quality German beer, when it is manufactured in the U.S. with domestic ingredients.
